In March, the Shirley J. Luck Center for 50+ had approximately 1675 people at the center. The membership has grown to 388 members of which 80 are new to the center this year. In addition, there are the 65 Lifetime members over the age of 90 making our total 453 members to date. I held a “Spring Fling” on April 15th to bring our newer members together with our established members for lunch and a video slide show of events from the past and present. We had about 40 people that attended and everyone seemed to have a really good time socializing and sharing stories.

We are welcoming Johnstown’s Pre-K classes with about 50 students to the center on April 23rd at 9am for “Pre-Kinder Garden”. Members are volunteering to come in and help the students plant flowers for Mother’s Day. We have a lot of fun with all the children and glad they are coming again this year.

On April 28th at 1pm Dr. Lauren Kozakiewicz will present “Interesting Women of Upstate New York” and lead us on a journey into the lives and contributions of key women leaders who hailed from upstate regions including the Mohawk Valley. We welcome everyone to join us for this event.

We have two presentations on Medicare 101 for people turning 65 and new to Medicare. On Wednesday, May 13th at 6pm a representative from OB1’s office in Mayfield will provide information and answer questions. On Thursday, May 28th at 10am MJ Murray, Licensed Insurance Agent will educate us on how to enroll in Medicare, what Parts A, B, C, and D mean, and the cost sharing and benefits associated with each letter. These are open to everyone in the community and free of charge.

The Spring Sale is on May 8th & 9th from 9am – 3pm and we have been taking in donations on scheduled days. We are looking for donations of items that are new or next to new that we can sell at the Spring Sale. It’s a good time of year to spring clean and we appreciate the donations. We will have a basket raffle with approximately 30 baskets to choose from. There will be a bake sale and the kitchen will be open for lunch on both days.

The next Defensive Driving Class will be held on Wednesday, May 27th from 9:30a-3:30p. Class size is limited to 40 and the cost is \$25 for members of the center and \$35 for guests. The class is being taught by Frank Clemente and you will get a discount on your insurance for attending the class. The next class will be on June 24th.
