 - 115 - Citations issued were Traffic Tickets.

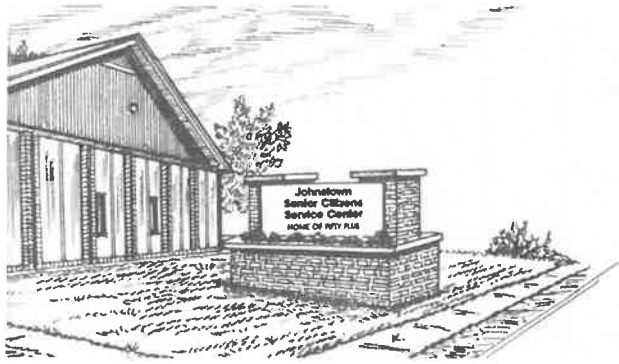
- There were 29 Traffic Accidents Investigated.

The Shirley J. Luck Center had 1,700 people attending a class, activity, or event in the month of March. Membership grows weekly and we currently have 364 paid members for 2025 plus 50 Lifetime members over the age of 90. Word of mouth keeps bringing new people into the center almost every day.

On Tuesday, April 1st we had a Pre-Kinder “Garden” activity with 54 pre-k children from Pleasant Avenue School. Several members volunteered to come in and work with the children to start flower and vegetable seeds in small plant pots. It was great to see the interaction and laughter as our members and the children worked with getting the dirt and seeds into the plant pots.

We are very busy getting ready for the “Spring Sale” on May 9th and 10th. Volunteers are accepting donations of items that are new, “next to new”, or gently used on Tuesday’s and Friday’s. A Basket Raffle coincides with the sale and raffle tickets go on sale May 5th. The kitchen will be open both days with food and drinks available to purchase. The Bake Sale with homemade goodies is on May 9th. Donations to the basket raffle and/or bake sale are greatly appreciated.

The Blood Pressure Clinic is every 3rd Thursday from 9am – 1pm. This is a free check on your blood pressure and a chance to talk to the nurse if you have concerns. Everyone in the community is welcome to stop in to get their blood pressure checked. You are then welcome to enjoy a cup of coffee and a snack.

The Caregiver Support Group meets on the 4th Wednesday of each month at 3pm and is open to everyone in the community. This is a safe place to share stories and get support and understanding from other caregivers. The group provides educational, emotional, and social support for anyone caregiving for someone with health issues or dementia.

The next Defensive Driving Class will be held on Wednesday, April 30th from 9:30a-3:30p. A class is held every month through December with the next on Wednesday, May 28th. Class size is limited to 40 and the cost is \$25 for members of the center and \$35 for guests. The class is being taught by Frank Clemente and you will get a discount on your insurance for attending the class.
