In the month of **August**, the Fire department conducted in-service training on Residential Ventilation techniques, the Code division continued Training on Commercial Plan review and the EMS division continued training on completing and reviewing Patient Care Reports (PCRs).

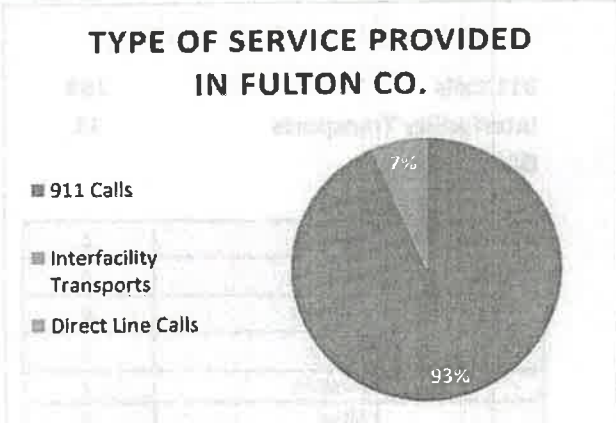

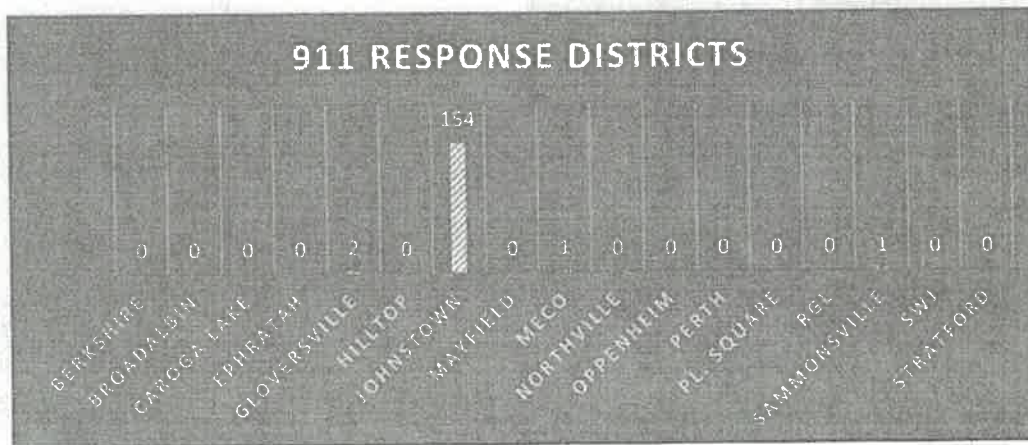

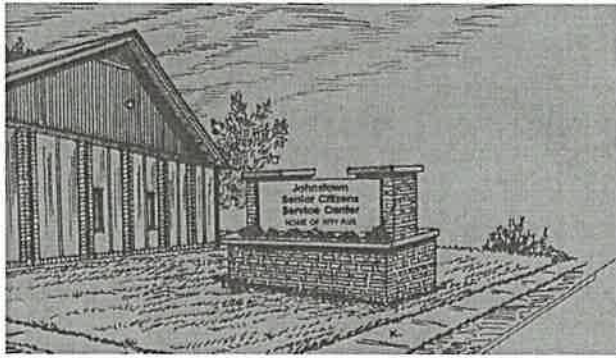

The Shirley J. Luck Center for 50+ is looking forward to a very busy fall with a big event scheduled each month through December. September is "Senior Center Month" and starts our membership drive for 2024. We will be showcasing all that we do at our "Fall Fest" on Thursday, September 21st from 11a-3p in our parking lot. There will be a membership table with information and applications for anyone wanting to sign up or renew their membership for 2024. The cost is only \$20 for the year and you will be entered into a drawing to win \$50 or \$25 when your membership for 2024 is paid by December 31st. The drawing will be on January 4, 2024. There will be staff and volunteers available to answer questions about our classes, events, and anything else about the center.
