The following questions were asked of departments:

Public Works: Spritzer asked for an update on paving. Vose stated that asphalt quantities are running higher than expected and may need to adjust the streets being resurfaced. Spritzer asked if a homeowner, when repairing their sidewalk, is responsible for making corners ADA compliant. Vose confirmed but the city will work with them if necessary.
