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## ASSESSOR REPORT December 16, 2024

- Property Owners 65 years of age and older MAY be eligible for the Partial Tax Exemption for Senior Citizens on their PRIMARY RESIDENCE. Total Household Income MUST be \$29,999 or less for tax year 2023 to qualify. Contact the Assessor's office at 518-736-4015 for an application.
- **Renewal** applications for the Partial Tax Exemption for Senior Citizens were mailed November 6<sup>th</sup> and are due by March 1, 2025. **Please submit income from the tax year 2023.**
- The Assessor's Office continues to work on the 2025 roll.



# **Johnstown Fire Department Monthly Report**

## **Month of November 2024**

### **Training:**

In service training for Fire, EMS, and Code Enforcement focused on finishing up training requirements for the year.

### **Fire Department Activity:**

The department responded to 169 calls for emergencies.

On 11/30/2024 we provided mutual aid to the city of Gloversville for a structure fire.

Fire dept personnel conducted vehicle maintenance on all dept vehicles.

### **EMS Activity:**

The department EMS personnel responded to 111 calls for service. Our new ambulance is fully in service now, and is a welcome addition to our fleet.

### **Code Enforcement:**

This month the codes division issued 52 building permits with an estimated cost of construction \$496,379.00. Permit fees collected for this period was \$2062.50

The code department conducted multiple inspections, and investigated complaints as received.

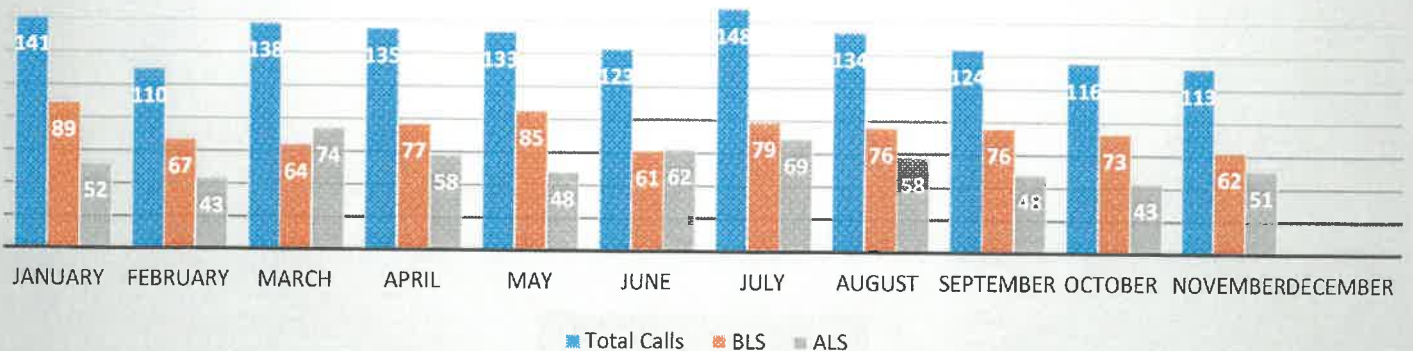

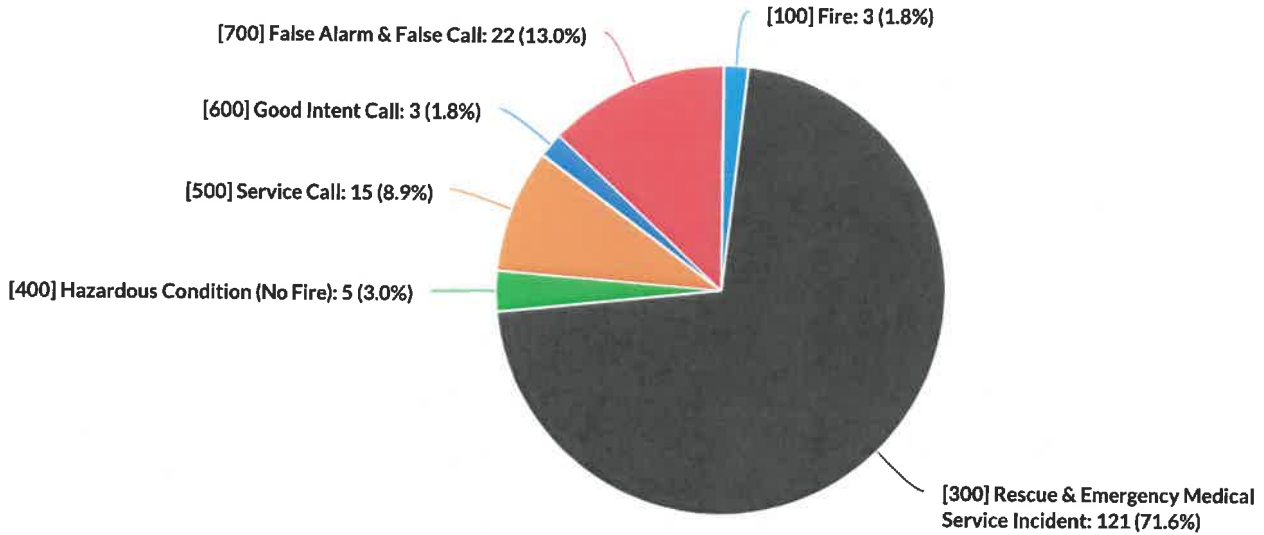

- In the process of hiring a certified officer to fill our last vacancy, bringing the Police Department to full strength. Hope to have him on the payroll within the next week. Officer will still go through our Field Training Program which consists of 12 Weeks.

The center made about \$1300 from the breakfast and raffles which will go towards the new refrigerator we recently had to purchase. The center truly appreciates all the support from our members and friends in the community. Our membership drive has brought in 184 members either renewing or new for 2025, and we continue to see it grow almost daily.

The Eavesdropper calendar for January has a change and going forward we are flip flopping our Wednesday and Thursday events to better accommodate our members coming in those days. The first Wednesday will now have our Membership Recognition and Bingo and the following ones will have things like Game Day, Yahoo, Corn Hole, and informational speakers. Thursday will have our pitch and pinochle card players along with the Chicken Foot domino players. All our members are welcome to join in any of these days and bring a friend to find out what we have to offer.
