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Calls Handled:

- For the month of September 2023, the Police Department handled 443 calls for service.

- There were, 51 Citations issued.

Training & Other News:

- We have had our first virtual training on the body camera's. We are currently awaiting hardware from the company so officers can attach camera's to there vests. While waiting on the hardware we are setting up our department camera system software. We are also in talks with Axon since our Company Contact no longers works for Axon so there are issues we are working out with the company as we work thru the setup process.

- Our Tasers are in and have been setup with the correct hardware and software programs. Department wide training will be conducted in the middle of November. Once training is complete all patrol and detective members will be equiped tasers.
