I want to thank all the volunteers and everyone who came out and supported the center. The breakfast raised \$1,300.00 which goes towards improvements at the center. We purchased a new stove just prior to the breakfast and were able to sell the old one through an auction site. We now have ovens with correct temperatures so we can bake cakes, cookies and other homemade treats for our members to enjoy when they are here.

A big thank you to Perfection Cleaning for making the dining room and hallway floors shine beautifully again. Joe Semione generously donated the 3 days of work to complete the process. He wanted to show his appreciation for the good work and services we provide for older adults in our community.

The Farmer's Market is in the parking lot every Tuesday through October from 3-6pm. They have about 10 vendors with a variety of fresh vegetables and fruits, ice cream and cookies from Wemple & Edick's, and music playing while you shop.

Sheriff Richard Giardino was here on July 8th at 1pm to speak about scams and keeping yourself and your home safe. The event was well attended and the Sheriff actually got a scam call during the presentation which made it all the more fun, especially when he identified himself to the caller.
