Month of July

Training:

In the month of July the fire department continued in-service training, fire-ground operations including pump training and aerial apparatus placement. Code enforcement officers conducted training on rooftop solar arrays on commercial and residential properties. Paramedics and EMTs conducted training on cardiac emergencies.

Fire Department Activity:

The Fire Department was busy preparing for Chief Heberer's retirement.

July was one of our busiest months to date. The Fire Department responded to 192 calls for service. These included, 4 fires, 19 service calls, 3 hazardous conditions, 11 good intent calls, and 20 false alarm and false calls.

EMS Activity

Emergency medical services responded to 135 calls for service.

Code Enforcement

The July monthly Building Permit Report is as follows:

There were 49 building permits issued with an estimated cost of Construction or Renovation is \$761,892.00. The permit fees collected for this are \$3305.00.

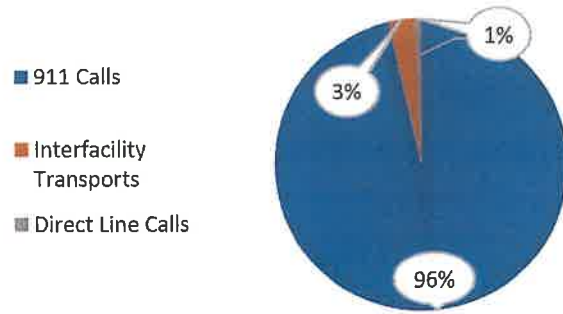

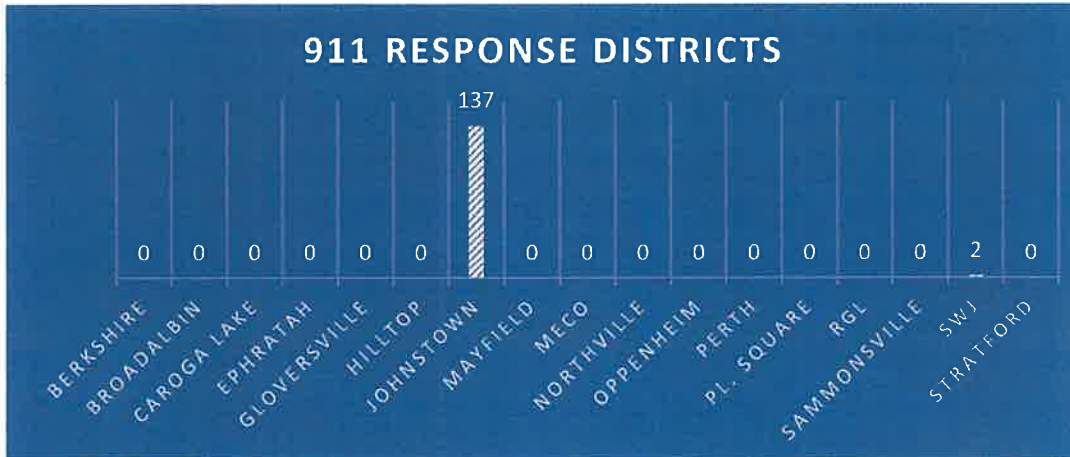

We are keeping the cost of membership at \$20 for the year and you get discounts on classes, trips, and events. The kitchen will be open, and we will have a membership table with information, along with featuring some of our classes and activities.
