# Johnstown Fire Department Monthly Report

## Month of August 2024

### **Training:**

In service training for FIRE / EMS focused on working safely in the roadways. The department is also conducting CPR and AED training for all members.

### **Fire Department Activity:**

The department responded to 187 calls for emergencies.

On 8/29/2024 we had a significant incident in the city of Gloversville. There was a large mill fire resulting in the recall of all department personnel.

Our union members conducted our annual boot drive collecting over \$4000.00 for MDA

### **EMS Activity:**

The department EMS personnel responded to 123 calls for service.

### **Code Enforcement:**

This month the codes division issued 61 building permits with an estimated cost of construction \$633,177.56. Permit fees collected for this period was \$2772.50

The code department conducted multiple inspections, and investigated complaints as received.

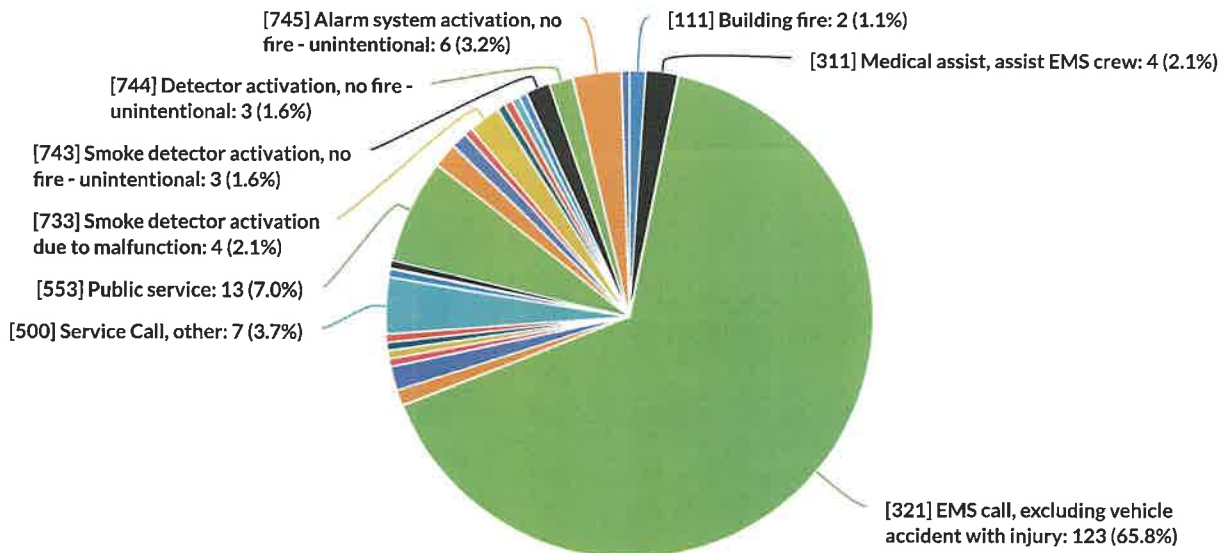
