INFORMATION TO OBTAIN A MARRIAGE LICENSE

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS YOU MUST SUBMIT ONE DOCUMENT FROM EACH COLUMN

One (1) of the following forms of photo ID

- Driver's License / Permit
- Non-Driver ID
- Passport
- Employment / Military ID

One (1) of the following to prove birth:

- Birth Certificate
- Baptism / Christening Certificate w/ date of birth listed
- Naturalization papers

AGE REQUIREMENTS

- If either applicant is under 17 years of age, a marriage license cannot be issued.
- If either applicant is 17 years of age, such applicant(s) must present the written consent of both parents and a justice of the Supreme Court or a judge of the Family Court having jurisdiction over the city in which the application is made. One parent alone may consent to a minor's marriage if:
 - The other parent has been missing for one year preceding the application;
 - The parents are divorced and the consenting parent was given sole custody of the child when the divorce decree was awarded;
 - The other parent has been judged incompetent; or the other parent is deceased. Parents, guardians or other people consenting to the marriage of a minor must personally appear and acknowledge or execute their consent before the city clerk.
- If both applicants are 18 years of age or older, no consents are required.
- Licenses are issued Monday Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. 2:30 p.m. by appointment.
- \$40.00 fee (fee waived for <u>active</u> duty military; documentation required).
- Application must be completed:

- Licenses are issued, in person, at the City Clerk's office and both parties must be present to sign the Affidavit.
- If there are any previous marriages, you must provide proof of divorce, annulment or death for each marriage.
- License must be obtained at least 24 hours in advance of the ceremony and is valid for 60 days (180 for <u>active</u> duty military).
- License is only valid in New York State.
- Once the ceremony has taken place the license must be returned to the Clerk's office where the license was issued. The marriage will be filed with New York State and a Certificate of Marriage will be mailed to the couple.
