WHEREAS, the One Church Street Food Pantry has recently celebrated its first anniversary in a bright and accessible new space, ensuring that every neighbor can enter with dignity and receive support without barriers; and

WHEREAS, in the past year alone, the One Church Street Food Pantry has provided more than 68,000 meals to the community, with 31% of its guests being children, demonstrating its profound impact on the youngest and most vulnerable among us; and

WHEREAS, the NOAH (Needy or Alone and Hungry) program continues to serve an average of 112 meals per week, reflecting a 6% increase each year and meeting a steadily growing need in our community; and

WHEREAS, One Church Street has expanded its *Food is Medicine* program, offering healthy cooking classes and a 12-week program designed specifically for diabetic and pre-diabetic patients, fostering both wellness and education; and

WHEREAS, One Church Street embodies the spirit of service, nourishing our community in mind, body, and spirit, and strengthening the bonds of compassion and care that make our city thrive;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that I, Amy Praught, Mayor of the City of Johnstown, do hereby recognize and commend **One Church Street** for its decades of dedicated service, its innovative programs, and its unwavering commitment to feeding, educating, and uplifting our community.

WHEREAS, September 17, 2025, marks the two hundred and thirty-eighth anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize this magnificent document and the anniversary of its creation; and

WHEREAS, it is the patriotic duty of citizens to protect, defend, and preserve the Constitution of the United States so that future generations may continue to enjoy the many blessings of freedom and the rights of citizenship; and

WHEREAS, the tradition of celebrating Constitution Week was officially established in 1956 by President Dwight D. Eisenhower to encourage Americans to reflect on the importance of this historical document and to educate themselves about their rights and responsibilities as citizens; and

WHEREAS, we encourage all citizens to reaffirm the ideals of the Framers of the Constitution by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties.
