FEES FOR THE YEAR 2026**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-602.1 of the City Code of Ordinances entitled Transfer Station charges, the Common Council shall set the cost of a landfill permit prior to the commencement of the fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, the Common Council sets the cost for 2026 landfill permits at:

1. Annual Fee: \$35.00
2. Replacement Sticker: Users will be charged a fee of \$5.00 for each replacement sticker requested due to loss, damage or to transfer to a new vehicle.
3. Partial Year: After September 30th residents may purchase a Landfill Permit at a reduced cost of \$20.00.
